Thank you for another incredible season of Minor Hockey, for the 2023-2024 year. As our 2024-2025 Registration is now open, we would like to take this opportunity to provide information on the registration fees and programming, as the fees have increased.

U9 DIVISION:

As we are structuring our programming on player development at the earliest possible age group, we have continued to offer Moni Johnson Power Skating Skills in our U9 Division. This is at a cost to Lawfield Minor Hockey, and <u>NOT</u> an additional cost to the U9 Members. Other arenas are offering skills at an additional cost \$20 per session. Moni has over 29 years of experience in all levels, as well as her coaches provide multiple years of experience.

U11 and U13 DIVISIONS:

For the U11 and U13 Divisions, we offer 5 additional 1-hour skills sessions for each team with Randy Dalgleish (former instructor at On Ice, house league and select coach and mentor) and John McVey (house league and select coach and Hockey School Mentor), both with multiple years of experience. This is **NOT** at an additional cost to Lawfield Members.

U15 DIVISION:

For the U15 Division, our programming will start with one game time and one practice time per week. After the winter break, this will adjust to a 2 game per week schedule, with the potential to add in a monthly practice to work on player development, dependent on ice time and number of teams.

U18 DIVISION:

For the U18 Division our programming has remained the same with a 2 game per week schedule due to player's work and school commitments; both academic and sports.

U11 to U18 DIVISIONS:

For all members outside of the U9 Division that take part in the Power Skating Skills programming, we continue to work with Moni Johnson to reduce the costs for the 2nd and 3rd hour of ice. This provides an opportunity for members from U11-U18 to take part in the Power Skating Skills programming at a reduced cost.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION/INCREASE IN FEES:

Referees, ice rental and basic running costs have gone up considerably across the board. The organization has been mindful of increasing costs of hockey programming, while at the same time understanding the realities of keeping the organization operational within our community. Due to these rising costs, we have had to increase our fees for the 2024-2025 Season.

While the cost of our programming may be higher than other associations, we believe that we offer the most competitive and structured programming with our main focus on development, beginning at the earliest age. In an effort to alleviate these costs, we continue to build strong relationships and remain loyal with businesses in the community, in exchange for continued Sponsorship support which reduce the cost for our members.
